## 1 The Hearth Tax

The Hearth Tax was introduced by Charles II in 1662 and finally repealed by William and Mary in 1689. Each liable householder was required to pay one shilling per hearth twice yearly, at Michaelmas and on Lady Day. The surviving records relate to the years when the tax was administered centrally, with records returned to the Exchequer. At other times the collection was by private collectors, who paid a fixed sum to the government in return for the right to collect the tax. Very few returns survive from these years.

Only people whose house was worth more than 20 shillings a year, and who contributed to local church and poor rates, were liable for the hearth tax. You were exempt also if your annual income was less than £100.

The only years with records surviving for Great Ayton and Little Ayton are 1662, 1664, 1670 and 1673.
